Among startups focused on innovation, only <u>4.7 percent</u> are founded exclusively by women. Even as the number of female entrepreneurs continues to grow, gender parity in the industry remains largely unrealized. What are factors that contribute to this reality? What challenges do women face in accessing credit? How does the venture capital industry, still largely male-dominated, perpetuate this inequality? How can women use their unique perspective and voice to build their business, in spite of these challenges? Entrepreneurs and innovators will discuss these and other topics including financial planning, innovation, and the role of government in the entrepreneurial ecosystem.
